SUMMARY ORDER OF REPRIMAND

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537

The above captioned matter comes on for Commission action through a summary proceeding under the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act, K.S.A. 77-537, regarding the law enforcement certification of respondent, FRANCISCO FEDELIN.

1. FRANCISCO FEDELIN (Respondent), is a holder of a certification from the Kansas Commission on Peace Officers’ Standards and Training;
2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5616(b)(1), the Commission may reprimand any police or law enforcement officer who fails to meet and maintain the requirements of K.S.A. 74-5605 or K.S.A. 74-5607a, and amendments thereto;
3. K.S.A. 74-5607a(b) states that “every full-time police officer or law enforcement officer shall complete annually 40 hours of law enforcement education or training.”
4. Respondent submitted thirty-five (35) hours of annual training for training year (TY) 2017 [July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017].

5. A notice of the training hour delinquency was sent to the Hugoton Police Department on August 3, 2017.
6. Respondent submitted a request for an extension of TY 2017 on August 7, 2017. The request was approved and returned to Respondent, which he signed on August 25, 2017. Respondent was given until September 14, 2017 to meet the requirement (5 delinquent hours).
7. At the expiration of his extension on September 14, 2017, Respondent was delinquent one (1) training hour.
8. Respondent submitted training hours to satisfy his TY 2017 delinquency on September 15, 2017. This training was attended after the extension had expired.
9. Under K.S.A. 77-537, the Commission may conduct these summary proceedings, subject to respondent's request for a hearing. The Commission finds that the use of summary proceedings in these circumstances does not violate any provisions of law and the protection of the public interest does not require the Commission to give notice and opportunity to participate to any person other than respondent.

ORDER

Based on Respondent failing to complete the training requirement for TY 2017 pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5607a(b), the Commission orders that a reprimand be issued.

ACCORDINGLY THE KANSAS COMMISSION ON PEACE OFFICERS'
STANDARDS AND TRAINING ISSUES A REPRIMAND TO FRANCISCO FEDELIN.


NOTICE OF RELIEF FROM THIS SUMMARY ORDER
