SUMMARY ORDER OF REPRIMAND

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537

The above captioned matter comes on for Commission action through a summary proceeding under the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act, K.S.A. 77-537, regarding the law enforcement certification of LANDON WISELEY.

1. LANDON WISELEY (Respondent), holds a certification from the Kansas Commission on Peace Officers’ Standards and Training.
2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5616(b)(1), the Commission may reprimand any police or law enforcement officer who fails to meet and maintain the requirements of K.S.A. 74-5605 or K.S.A. 74-5607a, and amendments thereto.
3. K.S.A. 74-5607a(b) states that “every full-time police officer or law enforcement officer shall complete annually 40 hours of law enforcement education or training.”
4. Respondent submitted zero (0) hours of annual training for training year (TY) 2018 [July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018].
5. A notice of the training hour delinquency was sent to Respondent at the Conway Springs Police Department on August 1, 2018.

6. Respondent did not submit a request for an extension, modification, or waiver of TY 2018 training hours.
7. As of January 17, 2018, Respondent has failed to submit any training for TY 2018.
8. Under K.S.A. 77-537, the Commission may conduct these summary proceedings, subject to respondent's request for a hearing. The Commission finds that the use of summary proceedings in these circumstances does not violate any provisions of law and the protection of the public interest does not require the Commission to give notice and opportunity to participate to any person other than respondent.

ORDER

Based on Respondent failing to complete the training requirement for TY 2018 pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5607a(b), the Commission orders that a reprimand be issued.

Respondent shall complete forty (40) hours of TY 2018 training hours by March 15, 2018⁹, or he may be subject to further certification action by the Commission. This requirement is in addition to the forty-hour TY 2019 training requirement that must be completed by June 30, 2019.

ACCORDINGLY THE KANSAS COMMISSION ON PEACE OFFICERS' STANDARDS AND TRAINING ISSUES A REPRIMAND TO LANDON WISELEY.


NOTICE OF RELIEF FROM THIS SUMMARY ORDER
