SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537

The above-captioned matter comes on for Commission action through a summary proceeding under the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act, K.S.A. 77-537, regarding the law enforcement certification of SUTAGEE ANGLIN (Respondent).

STATEMENT OF FACTS

1. Respondent holds a full-time law enforcement certification from the Kansas Commission on Peace Officers' Standards and Training (Commission), certification number 376.
2. Respondent was employed as a full-time law enforcement officer with the Lawrence Police Department from September 13, 2004 to January 24, 2019.
3. On August 19, 2018, Respondent and his wife, C.A., got into an argument. C.A. was afraid Respondent would become more violent, so C.A. attempted to call her daughter to come pick up C.A. and the two children that lived in the residence. Respondent grabbed the phone out of C.A.'s hand. When

C.A. tried to get her phone back, Respondent held her down on the couch and would not let her leave the home.

4. Based on his conduct on August 19, 2018, Respondent was criminally charged in the District Court of Douglas County, Case Number 2018-CR000886. On January 8, 2019, Respondent entered a Diversion Agreement on one count of criminal restraint, contrary to K.S.A. 21-5411, a class A person misdemeanor. Respondent signed a Stipulation of Facts stating that on or about August 19, 2018, he unlawfully, knowingly, and without legal authority restrained C.A. so as to interfere substantially with her liberty, all in violation of K.S.A. 21-5411.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Criminal Conduct

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5616(b)(5), the Commission may revoke the certification of any police or law enforcement officer who engages in conduct which, if charged as a crime, would constitute a felony crime under the laws of this state, a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence as defined in the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Act at the time the conduct occurred, or a misdemeanor crime that the Commission determines reflects on the honesty, trustworthiness, integrity or competence of the applicant as defined by rules and regulations of the Commission.
6. K.A.R. 106-2-2a(a)(4) states that pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5616 and amendments thereto, an applicant or officer shall not engage in conduct, whether or not charged as a crime or resulting in a conviction, that would constitute criminal restraint, as defined in K.S.A. 21-5411 and amendments thereto.
7. Respondent's conduct against C.A. on August 19, 2018 constitutes criminal restraint.

Good Moral Character

8. Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5616(b)(1) the Commission may revoke the certification of a police or law enforcement officer who fails to meet and maintain the requirements of K.S.A. 74-5605 or 74-5607a, and amendments thereto.
9. K.S.A. 74-5605(b)(5) states that each applicant for certification shall be of good moral character sufficient to warrant the public trust in the applicant as a police officer or law enforcement officer.
10. K.A.R. 106-2-4(a) defines good moral character as including the personal traits or qualities of integrity, honesty, upholding the laws of the state and nation, conduct that warrants the public trust, and upholding the oath required for certification as specified in K.A.R. 106-3-6.
11. Pursuant to K.A.R. 106-2-4(b), any single incident or event may suffice to show that an applicant or licensee lacks or has failed to maintain good moral character.
12. Respondent's conduct resulting in his conviction in the District Court of Douglas County, Case Number 2018-CR000886, shows that he lacks the personal qualities of integrity, honesty, upholding the laws of the state, conduct that warrants the public trust, and upholding the oath required for certification.

Summary Proceedings

13. Under K.S.A. 77-537, the Commission may conduct these summary proceedings, subject to Respondent's request for a hearing. The Commission finds that the use of summary proceedings in these circumstances does not violate any provisions of law and the protection of

the public interest does not require the Commission to give notice and opportunity to participate to any person other than Respondent.

ORDER

Based on these Statement of Facts and Conclusions of Law, the Commission orders that the Kansas Law Enforcement Officer Certification of SUTAGEE ANGLIN be revoked.

ACCORDINGLY, THE KANSAS COMMISSION ON PEACE OFFICERS' STANDARDS AND TRAINING CERTIFICATE OF SUTAGEE ANGLIN IS HEREBY REVOKED.

FURTHER, Respondent is ordered to surrender and return to the Commission all evidence of his certification as a law enforcement officer.

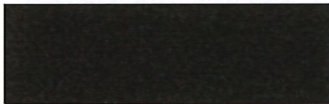
NOTICE OF RELIEF FROM THIS SUMMARY ORDER
