**SUMMARY ORDER OF REPRIMAND**

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537

The above captioned matter comes on for Commission action through a summary proceeding under the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act, K.S.A. 77-537, regarding the law enforcement certification of ADAM JACKSON.

1. ADAM JACKSON (Respondent), holds a certification from the Kansas Commission on Peace Officers’ Standards and Training.
2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5616(b)(1), the Commission may reprimand any police or law enforcement officer who fails to meet and maintain the requirements of K.S.A. 74-5605 or K.S.A. 74-5607a, and amendments thereto.
3. K.S.A. 74-5607a(b) states that “every full-time police officer or law enforcement officer shall complete annually 40 hours of law enforcement education or training.”
4. Respondent submitted eleven and one half (11.5) hours of annual training for training year (TY) 2018 [July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018].

5. Respondent submitted a request for extension of TY 2018 on July 6, 2018. The request was approved and returned to Respondent. Respondent was given until October 29, 2018 to meet the requirement (29.5 delinquent hours).
6. Respondent failed to submit any additional training hours during the extension period ending October 29, 2018. Respondent submitted eight hours on November 18, 2018. As of January 17, 2019, Respondent is delinquent for TY 2018 by 21.5 hours.
7. Under K.S.A. 77-537, the Commission may conduct these summary proceedings, subject to respondent's request for a hearing. The Commission finds that the use of summary proceedings in these circumstances does not violate any provisions of law and the protection of the public interest does not require the Commission to give notice and opportunity to participate to any person other than respondent.

### ORDER


Based on Respondent failing to complete the training requirement for TY 2018 pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5607a(b), the Commission orders that a reprimand be issued.

**Respondent shall complete twenty-one and one half (21.5) hours of TY 2018 training hours by March 15, 2019, or he may be subject to further certification action by the Commission.**

ACCORDINGLY THE KANSAS COMMISSION ON PEACE OFFICERS' STANDARDS AND TRAINING ISSUES A REPRIMAND TO ADAM JACKSON.


**NOTICE OF RELIEF FROM THIS SUMMARY ORDER**
