SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537

The above-captioned matter comes on for Kansas Commission on Peace Officers' Standards and Training (Commission) action through a summary proceeding under the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act, K.S.A. 77-537, regarding the law enforcement certification of CHANSE HENRE (Respondent).

STATEMENT OF FACTS

1. The Commission issued Respondent a full-time law enforcement certification, certification number 28859.
2. Respondent was employed as a full-time law enforcement officer with the Kansas City Kansas Police Department from December 10, 2015 to November 13, 2020.
3. Respondent was charged with one count of Domestic Battery in the City of Edwardsville, Kansas, Ticket Number 70000. On June 13, 2020,

Respondent entered a Diversion Agreement for violating municipal ordinance Section 3.1.1(a)(1) Domestic Battery.

4. The City of Edwardsville, Kansas has adopted the Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities (UPOC). Pursuant to UPOC 3.1.1(a)(1), domestic battery, is knowingly or recklessly causing bodily harm to a person with whom the offender is involved or has been involved in a dating relationship or a family or household member. Violation of UPOC 3.1.1(a)(1) constitutes a "Misdemeanor Crime of Domestic Violence" pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5602(j).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Fail to Maintain Minimum Requirements for Certification

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5616(b)(1) the Commission may revoke the certification of a police or law enforcement officer who fails to meet and maintain the requirements of K.S.A. 74-5605 or 74-5607a, and amendments thereto.

Misdemeanor Crime of Domestic Violence

6. K.S.A. 74-5605(b)(3) states that each applicant for certification shall not have been convicted of a crime that would constitute a felony under the laws of this state, a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence or a misdemeanor offense that the Commission determines reflects on the honesty, trustworthiness, integrity or competence of the applicant as defined by rules and regulations of the Commission.
7. K.S.A. 74-5605(d) states that as used in this section, "conviction" includes any diversion or deferred judgment agreement entered into for a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence.

8. K.S.A. 74-5602(j) defines misdemeanor crime of domestic violence to include a misdemeanor under municipal law that has as an element the use or attempted use of physical force committed against a person with whom the offender is involved or has been involved in a “dating relationship” or is a “family or household member.” Respondent’s violation of UPOC 3.1.1(a)(1) constitutes a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence.
9. Due to his diversion agreement entered into for a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence, Respondent fails to meet and maintain the requirements of K.S.A. 74-5605.

Good Moral Character

10. K.S.A. 74-5605(b)(5) states that each applicant for certification shall be of good moral character sufficient to warrant the public trust in the applicant as a police officer or law enforcement officer.
11. K.A.R. 106-2-4(a) defines good moral character as including the personal traits or qualities of integrity, honesty, upholding the laws of the state and nation, conduct that warrants the public trust, and upholding the oath required for certification as specified in K.A.R. 106-3-6.
12. Pursuant to K.A.R. 106-2-4(b), any single incident or event may suffice to show that an applicant or licensee lacks or has failed to maintain good moral character.
13. Respondent’s conduct shows that he lacks the personal qualities of integrity, honesty, upholding the laws of the state, conduct that warrants the public trust, and upholding the oath required for certification.

Summary Proceedings

14. Under K.S.A. 77-537, the Commission may conduct these summary proceedings, subject to Respondent's request for a hearing. The Commission finds that the use of summary proceedings in these circumstances does not violate any provisions of law and the protection of the public interest does not require the Commission to give notice and opportunity to participate to any person other than Respondent.

ORDER


Based on these Statement of Facts and Conclusions of Law, the Commission orders that the Kansas Law Enforcement Officer Certification of CHANSE HENREBe revoked.

ACCORDINGLY, THE KANSAS COMMISSION ON PEACE OFFICERS' STANDARDS AND TRAINING CERTIFICATE OF CHANSE HENRE IS HEREBY REVOKED.

FURTHER, Respondent is ordered to surrender and return to the Commission all evidence of his certification as a law enforcement officer.



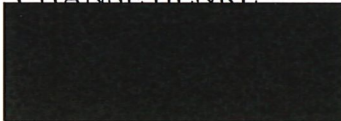
