### SUMMARY ORDER OF REPRIMAND

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537

The above-captioned matter comes on for action by the Kansas Commission on Peace Officers' Standards and Training (Commission) through a summary proceeding under the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act, K.S.A. 77-537, et seq., regarding the law enforcement certification of BRANDON HAY (Respondent).

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

- Respondent holds a certification from the Commission, certification number 25949.
- Respondent began law enforcement employment in Kansas in 2010.
   Respondent was employed as a full-time law enforcement officer with the Cherokee County Sheriff's Office from December 24, 2012, to November 25, 2014, and from August 8, 2016, to July 7, 2022.
- 3. Respondent submitted three hours of annual training for training year (TY) 2022 [July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022].
- 4. Respondent was terminated on July 7, 2022, for failing to successfully complete his annual training as required by the Kansas Law Enforcement

Training Act, K.S.A. 74-5601 *et seq*. At the time of his termination. Respondent was thirty-seven hours delinquent in his training for TY 2022.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5616(b)(1), the Commission may suspend, condition, or revoke the certification of a police officer or law enforcement officer, reprimand or censure a police or law enforcement officer, or deny the certification of a police officer or law enforcement officer who fails to meet and maintain the requirements of K.S.A. 74-5605 or K.S.A. 74-5607a, and amendments thereto.
- 6. K.S.A. 74-5607a(b) states that beginning the second year after certification, every full-time police officer or law enforcement officer shall complete annually 40 hours of law enforcement education or training in subjects relating directly to law enforcement.
- 7. Pursuant to K.A.R. 106-1-9, the annual continuing education or training required by K.S.A. 74-5607a(b), and amendments thereto, shall be obtained during the period from July 1 of the year in which the requirement arises through June 30 of the following year.
- 8. Respondent did not complete his TY 2022 annual continuing education or training in the required time.
- 9. Under K.S.A. 77-537, the Commission may conduct these summary proceedings, subject to respondent's request for a hearing. The Commission finds that the use of summary proceedings in these circumstances does not violate any provisions of law and the protection of the public interest does not require the Commission to give notice and opportunity to participate to any person other than respondent.

#### ORDER

Based on Respondent failing to complete the training requirement for TY 2022, the Commission orders that a REPRIMAND be issued.

ACCORDINGLY, THE KANSAS COMMISSION ON PEACE OFFICERS'
STANDARDS AND TRAINING ISSUES A REPRIMAND TO BRANDON HAY.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, in the event Respondent becomes reemployed as a Kansas law enforcement officer, he will be required to submit the thirty-seven hours of training he is delinquent for TY 2022 in addition to the hours required in the year that he is hired. The delinquent hours will be due at the expiration of the training year in which Respondent is hired. Failure to satisfy his delinquent training hours in the manner prescribed above may result in further certification action.
