**JOURNAL ENTRY LIFTING SUSPENSION**


COMES NOW the Kansas Commission on Peace Officers’ Standards and Training (Commission), by and through the Commission Investigative Committee, Commissioners Jeff Herrig, Chair, B. Cole Presley, and Timothy Bauer, in accordance with Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, and upon due consideration of the agency record, the Kansas Law Enforcement Training Act, K.S.A. 74-5601 *et seq.*, and applicable Kansas Administrative Regulations, and being duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On February 4, 2021, the Commission issued a Summary Order of Suspension (Order) regarding the law enforcement certification of Victory Ivory (Ivory), certification number 29923. The Suspension was based on the Investigative Committee’s conclusion that Ivory’s conduct violated K.S.A. 74-5616(b)(7) as set forth in K.A.R. 106-2-3(f) (unprofessional conduct - excessive physical force in carrying out a law enforcement objective). The Order imposed a one-year suspension, beginning March 6, 2020. The Order became effective as a final order.
2. The one-year period of suspension expires on March 6, 2022. The Commission has not received any new allegations concerning Mr. Ivory.




