SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-537

The above-captioned matter comes on for Commission action through a summary proceeding under the Kansas Administrative Procedures Act, K.S.A. 77-537, regarding the law enforcement certificate of MICHAEL L. WILLIAMS (Respondent).

STATEMENT OF FACTS

1. Respondent holds a full-time law enforcement certification from the Kansas Commission on Peace Officers' Standards and Training (Commission), certification number 21922.
2. Respondent was employed as a full-time police officer with the Sac & Fox Tribal Police Department (SFTPD) from November 5, 2013 to October 13, 2017.
3. The Commission received information that Respondent left the SFTPD amidst allegations that he may have falsified training and firearms qualification records, that he may have engaged in conduct that constitutes disorderly conduct and criminal threat, and that he may have falsified a time sheet for pay.

4. An interview with Respondent was necessary to investigate the allegations and to determine his continued suitability for law enforcement certification. Commission Investigator Michael Oliver scheduled an interview with Respondent for February 27, 2018. Investigator Oliver mailed notice of the interview to Respondent.
5. On February 21, 2018, Respondent contacted Investigator Oliver by phone. Respondent stated that he received the mailed interview notice, but that he would not attend the interview. Respondent stated that he found employment outside of law enforcement and does not intend to seek future employment as a law enforcement officer.
6. Respondent did not appear for his interview on February 27, 2018.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Failure to Cooperate in Commission Investigation

7. Pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5616(b)(3), the Commission may revoke the certification of a police or law enforcement officer who fails to cooperate in a Commission investigation to determine a person's continued suitability for law enforcement certification.
8. Respondent's failure to appear for his interview with Investigator Oliver constitutes failure to cooperate in a Commission investigation to determine a person's continued suitability for law enforcement certification.

Summary Proceedings

9. Under K.S.A. 77-537, the Commission may conduct these summary proceedings, subject to Respondent's request for a hearing. The Commission finds that the use of summary proceedings in these circumstances does not violate any provisions of law and the protection of the public interest does not require the Commission to give notice and opportunity to participate to any person other than Respondent.

ORDER

Based on the above Statement of Facts and Conclusions of Law, the Commission orders that the Kansas Law Enforcement Officer Certification of MICHAEL L. WILLIAMS be revoked.

ACCORDINGLY, THE KANSAS COMMISSION ON PEACE OFFICERS' STANDARDS AND TRAINING CERTIFICATE OF MICHAEL L. WILLIAMS IS HEREBY REVOKED.

FURTHER, respondent is ordered to surrender and return to the Commission all evidence of his certification as a law enforcement officer.

NOTICE OF RELIEF FROM THIS SUMMARY ORDER


